Over the winter, we have developed the "Clearview School Travel Plan! The plan has many different activities that you will start hearing about when you come back in September.

The Action plan has 4 different areas which include:

1. Engineering – we have identified actions within the school zone area to improve safety.
2. Encouragement – activities to increase walking to school.
3. Education – actions which will enhance knowledge and confidence in safe school zones.
4. Enforcement – focus on safety issues in school zones.

The benefits of our plan will aim to provide healthier children, less traffic and pollution, safer school zones and better academic performance.
