School Council – A Year in Review

Thank you to all of the parents who volunteered to be a part of the 2019-2020 School Council. Council members participated in our Welcome Staff evening in September and during various meetings, including but not limited to, regular School Council meetings and planning meetings for the closure of Byng.

Byng parents and community members have also been a part of a Transition Committee for Byng students moving to Clearview Meadows and a committee that looked at the possible renaming of Clearview Meadows as Byng students move over for September 2020. This committee reviewed data gathered during the survey that was sent out to both Clearview and Byng school communities. Based on the data gathered the committee made the recommendation to keep the name Clearview Meadows Elementary School. The Trustees voted to accept this recommendation and it passed at last week's Board meeting.

Transitioning to Clearview Meadows or Stayner Collegiate - Next Steps

Your child's school records will be transferred automatically to either Clearview Meadows (grades SK-6) or SCI (grade 7) for school start up. If you and your family move out of the area over the summer and are registering at a new school please let your new school know to contact CMES or SCI to request your child's OSR.

Bussing notices were sent to you directly through your email last week. These notifications were password protected. Remember to put in a backslash (/) between each set of numbers in the password. If you require further information, reach out to your child's new school the week before school starts. Contact information for CMES and SCI is on the first page of this document.

Final report cards are being emailed out to families this year. If you wish a printed copy of your child's report card please make this request once school resumes in the Fall.
